II. Treatment Recommendation

- ██████████ has extensive cancer originating from his right kidney. This is a case of metastatic renal cell carcinoma with multiple lung, liver, skeletal and lymphnodal metastases.
- Mr ██████████ symptoms are primary due to metastasis in the lung.
- At this point, ██████████ needs targeted or immunotherapy. He may explore one of the below treatment options:
 - Sutent – Sunitinib therapy
 - Axitinib + Pembrolizumab
 - Lenvatinib + Pembrolizumab
- The above options may be considered only after consultation from the treating Oncologist. Sunitinib is a well tolerated drug comparatively. Pembrolizumab is expensive, and mostly recommended if the patient does not responds to sunitinib treatment.
- Also, consider additional support from the supportive care team and Radiation Oncologist opinion for the lytic lesion in the bone and additionally can start Inj Denosumab 120mcg subcutaneous monthly once.
- Symptom relief for cough: May suggest lozenges and cough syrup sos antihistaminics.

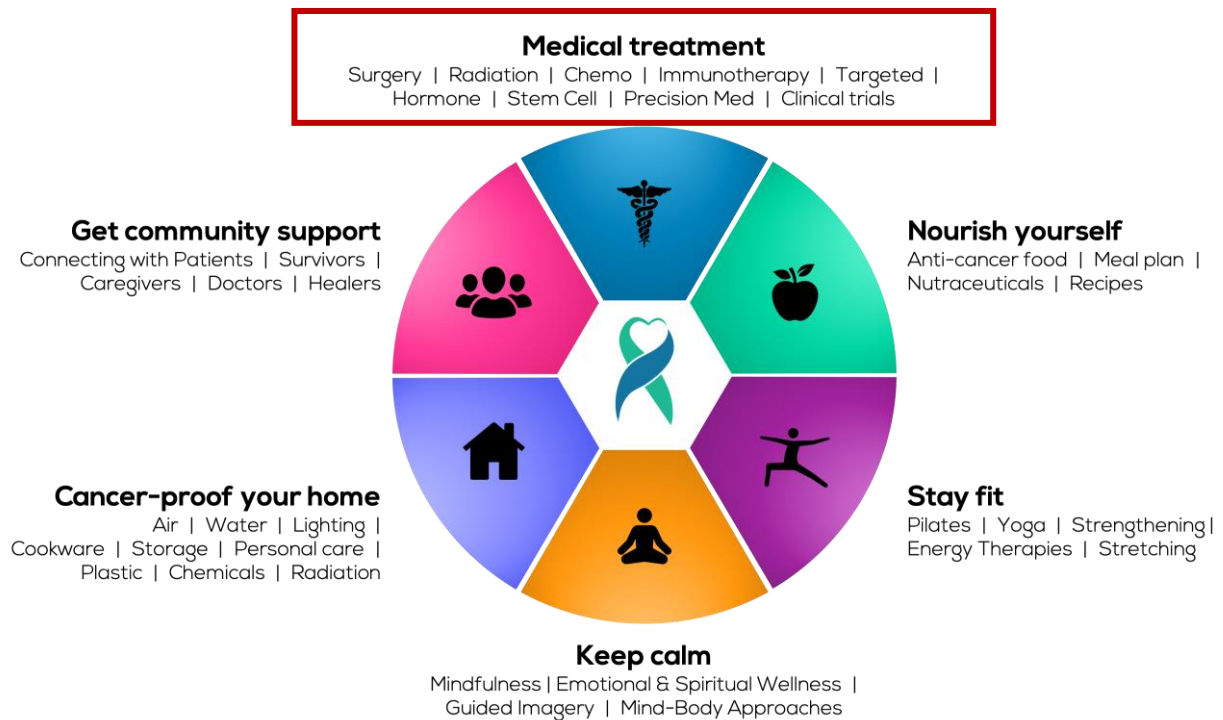
